3. QUARTERLY (YEAR-END) PRESENTATION - FINANCE DEPARTMENT

Finance Director William Klump provided the quarterly/year-end report for the Finance Department that ended September 30, 2021. With no one to speak in favor or opposition of this item, Mayor Kittner closed the public hearing.

Dr. Oubre provided that Dr. Johnston (applicant) attended the first City Council meeting and the first required public hearing at the Planning and Zoning meeting on October 26th. The Planning and Zoning Commission took action to recommend approval as submitted.

Mayor Pro Tem Giddings moved to recommend approval of the Application to Develop in a Planned District (new additions to South Bosque Veterinary Clinic) on a 1.75 acre tract, Joseph White Survey to the City of Woodway, McLennan County, Texas, located at 14000 Woodway Drive. Councilmember Russell seconded the motion, and the motion passed unanimously.

Dr. Oubre provided that the applicant is Brandon Rayne and this is for Texas Retina Associates. The first required public hearing was at the Planning and Zoning Commission meeting on October 26th. They took action to recommend approval as submitted.

Councilmember Cook moved to approve the Application to Develop in a Planned District (medical office) Lot 7, Block 8, of the Woodway Center Addition to the City of Woodway, McLennan County, Texas, located in the 200 Block of Archway Drive. Councilmember Qourzal seconded the motion, and the motion passed unanimously.

recommended by staff:

- Transfer \$1,000,000 from the General Fund to the General Capital Projects Fund.
- Transfer \$380,000 from the Tourism Fund to the Arboretum Construction fund for budgeted tourism capital improvements at the Arboretum.

Mayor Pro Tem Giddings moved to authorize the year end transfers as recommended by staff. Councilmember Russell seconded the motion, and the motion passed unanimously.

8. DISCUSSION AND CONSIDER ACTION ON RESOLUTION R-21-17, CASTING VOTES TO ELECT DIRECTORS FOR THE MCLENNAN COUNTY APPRAISAL DISTRICT FOR THE YEARS 2022-2023

Dr. Oubre provided comments regarding the City Council previously nominating Bridgette Fuselier and she has made it to the Offical Ballot. The City Council has 61 votes to cast which is based on the ranking of values or properties within the County.

There was a brief discussion.

Councilmember Mercer moved to cast all 61 votes for Ms. Fuselier. At this point, Councilmember Cook stated that she wanted to cast a portion of votes to Ms. Watkins. Councilmember Mercer then rescinded his original motion and moved to adopt Resolution R-21-17 casting 51 votes for Ms. Fuselier and 10 votes for Ms. Watkins. Councilmember Qourzal seconded the motion, and the motion passed unanimously.

Councilmember Russell moved to adjourn the meeting. Councilmember Avant seconded the motion, and the motion passed unanimously. The meeting adjourned at 5:56 p.m.
