

STREET RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

WHAT TYPE OF WORK IS BEING DONE?

This project is a reconstruction & improvement of the water, sewer, storm sewer, and streets in the specified areas.

WHO IS THE CONTRACTOR PERFORMING THE WORK?

The work will be performed by Barsh Construction, and overseen by the City and CP&Y, a third-party architectural firm.

WHAT STREETS ARE INCLUDED IN THIS PROJECT?

- (1) Harbor Drive from approximately Riverview toward approximately Rick Drive
- (2) Brookhollow Drive
- (3) White River Drive
- (4) Little River Drive

HOW WILL TRAFFIC BE AFFECTED?

Citizens will maintain access to their homes throughout the project with minimal inconvenience. The contractor will provide notice via door hanger at least 72 hours prior to commencement of construction, and you may also refer to the provided schedule.

Trash and recycling pick up, mail, and other deliveries should not be affected.

WILL I BE ABLE TO GET OUT OF MY DRIVEWAY?

Work will be performed between the hours of 7:00am and 4:00pm. It is possible that equipment may block the driveway at points throughout the day as required by the construction, but the contractor will not leave any equipment parked after hours in such a way that any resident's driveway is not accessible.

If you find that you are unable to access your driveway for an extended period, you may contact the job superintendent. His information will be provided on the door hanger you will receive prior to construction.

HOW WILL DUST AND CONSTRUCTION MESS BE DEALT WITH?

The Contractor will be responsible for keeping the area reasonably clean and minimizing dust. If there are questions or concerns, you will receive a door hanger that will contain contact information for the job superintendent, who will be your first point of contact during construction.
