

Debris Removal Addendum 1

Question 1: “Contractor wishes to remove debris from hazardous tree removal as regular vegetation and not have crew(s) following tree crews.” Contractor requests an RFP addendum.

The City discussed with its largest utility provider, and after power restoration, this company will have a contractor remove all debris from rights-of-way. No change needed.

Question 2: Is this a “standby” contract?

Yes. This is a standby contract.

Question 3: The blanks in K.26 - K.30 should be removed or clarified.

At this time, the City has access to only one landfill. Therefore, K.31 is the only section regarding landfill that needs to be completed.

Question 4: Page 38 R lists equipment a debris contractor plans to provide “not listed” in the initial equipment descriptions in Appendix B. Does the contractor provide these items and pricing?

Yes, contractor may add any additional equipment and rates for equipment not identified in the RFP.

Question 5: Should the City consider waterway debris removal?

The City leases an area along Lake Waco; however, there is no development along this area that the City manages. Waterway debris equipment will not be needed.
