



With drought conditions and extreme hot weather continuing in Woodway and the greater Waco area, the City of Woodway is issuing mandatory water restrictions for all water customers beginning Friday, July 15, 2022 at 12:01 a.m., allowing customers only three watering days per week. City Staff will continue to monitor conditions and advise of any changes. These restrictions pertain to irrigation of landscaped areas with hose-end sprinklers or automatic irrigation systems. Your cooperation is appreciated as the City organization adheres to this plan as well, and continues to find ways to cut back on water use by 25% in addition to following the schedule below. With many months of drought leading us into this very hot summer, please help us preserve our water source.

- No watering between the hours of 10 a.m. & 8 p.m. daily.
- Odd number addresses may water Mondays, Wednesdays, and Saturdays.
- Even number addresses may water Sundays, Tuesdays, and Thursdays.
- No watering on Fridays.
- Hand watering allowed on all days of the week.
- No washing of any motor vehicle, motorbike, boat, trailer, airplane nor any other vehicle between 10 a.m. & 8 p.m. on the designated watering days. Vehicle washing may be done at any time on the immediate premises of a commercial car wash or commercial service station.
- No watering to fill, refill, or add to any indoor or outdoor swimming pools, wading pools, or Jacuzzi-type pools between 10 a.m. and 8 p.m. on the designated watering days.

Under this stage in the plan, violations can reach up to \$500 per day per violation. For any concerns or questions, please call City Hall at 254.772.4480.
